### **NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE:** One (1)

**DUTIES:** Under the supervision of the Section Chief and/or Assistant Section Chief of the Personnel, Community Affairs, & Elections Section, responsible for handling a wide range of Second Injury Fund claims for total and permanent disability in Workers' Compensation Court, including allegations of workplace injuries or occupational exposure, together with pre-existing disability. Assignment involves nearly daily appearances in Workers' Compensation courts, where the cases are conferenced and litigated; may perform other related duties as required.

#### REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey required.

**EXPERIENCE:** DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 4: Two (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL 3: Three (3) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
