NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Assistant Attorneys General in charge of the Administrative Practice Group oversees the Public Utilities Section, which provides counsel to the Board of Public Utilities including providing advice on clean energy initiatives and advice and litigation services in matters involving ratepayers and third party vendors; plans and manages the supervision and operations of the Section; assigns matters and supervises Deputy Attorneys General in the Section; evaluates the performance of assigned Deputy Attorneys General; conducts case file reviews; and performs other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience as a practicing attorney, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate experience in the areas of public utilities, energy, and telecommunications law, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) practice and administrative law practice.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
