## **NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE:** One (1)

**DUTIES:** Under the supervision of the Assistant Attorneys General in charge of the Administrative Practice Group and/or the Section Chief of the Health and Human Services Section, provides counsel and representation to the Department of Human Services and the Department of Health; assists with planning and managing the supervision and operations of the Section; assigns matters and supervises Deputy Attorneys General in the Section; litigates and supervises litigation, as needed; evaluates the performance of assigned Deputy Attorneys General; conducts case file reviews; and, performs other duties as required.

### REQUIREMENTS

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey is required.

**EXPERIENCE:** Four (4) years of experience as a practicing attorney, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**PREFERENCE:** Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate experience in the areas of environmental law, administrative practice, civil litigation, contracts and real estate transactions.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
