<u>DUTIES:</u> Under the supervision of the Assistant Attorneys General in charge of the Financial Affairs and State Contracting Practice Group and the Section Chief of the Pensions and Financial Transactions Section, will provide counsel and representation to the Division of Pensions and Benefits, the various State pension and health boards and committees in the Department of Treasury; is responsible for assisting in the oversight and management of the Section, including staff supervision; representing the Section's clients; and performs other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney-at-Law in the State of New Jersey required.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience as a practicing attorney, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
